

WILDLAND URBAN INTERFACE (WUI) FUEL REDUCTION PROJECT
PERMISSION TO ENTER PROPERTY AND PERFORM WORK

Wayne County Fire District (“WCFD”) is participating in the WUI Fuel Reduction Along the Teasdale Front Project (the “Project”) for the purpose of mitigating the risk of wildfire in Wayne County, including establishing defensible space around homes and clearing surrounding high-density fuels.

The person(s) signing below (“Owner”) is/are the owner(s) of the property located at _____, Wayne County, Utah (the “Property”) and would like to participate in the Project. Owner grants WCFD, its employees, volunteers, and representatives, permission to enter the Property and perform work in connection with the Project. This work may include removal of branches, clearing of brush, tree removal, and other wildfire mitigation measures for the purpose of establishing defensible space around homes and private property (the “Work”). All Work will be performed in consultation with Owner. Owner understands that the purpose of the Project is to **reduce** the risk of damage to property from wildfire. However, there is no guaranty that the risk of wildfire will be eliminated or that structures or other property will be free from damage or destruction.

WCFD will endeavor to perform the Work in a professional manner and according to the agreed upon work plan. Owner agrees to release and hold harmless WCFD, its employees, volunteers, and representatives against all claims arising as a result of WCFD’s good faith efforts to perform the Work.

Owner may withdraw this permission and terminate Owner’s participation in the Project at any time, upon written notice to WCFD.
